THIS PUBLIC HEARING IS HELD WITH REGARD TO THE SUBMISSION OF A DISASTER RELIEF FUND APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF RURAL COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR A TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM (TXCDBG) GRANT.

The purpose of this meeting is to allow citizens an opportunity to discuss the Citizen Participation Plan, to obtain citizen comments on the development of a Disaster Relief application to address damages caused by April 2010 floods, and inform the citizens of TXCDBG funding available, all eligible TXCDBG activities, and the use of past TXCDBG funds.
