 - b. DENIED and you must hire your own lawyer if you want to be represented by counsel.**
- 4. PRE-TRIAL is set for _____, Defendants who do not appear will have their bonds forfeited and a warrant issued for their re-arrest. All counsel are required to attend all pre-trials. Failure to attend pre-trial and trial dates will result in removal of counsel from the Court's approved appointment list.**
- 5. PLEA NEGOTIATION DOCKET is set for _____. If a plea agreement has not been reached by that date, or the case otherwise disposed of, both the defendant and counsel must attend this docket. PLEA AGREEMENTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED BY THE COURT AFTER THIS DATE.**
- 6. THIS CASE IS SET FOR TRIAL _____ . CASES NOT REACHED FOR TRIAL THAT WEEK WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY RESET FOR TRIAL ON THE VERY NEXT TRIAL DOCKET. NO CONTINUANCES WILL BE GRANTED WITHOUT WRITTEN MOTION AND ORDER PRIOR TO TRIAL.**
