ORDER ADOPTING THE TAX RATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021

On this the 15th day of September, 2020 came to be considered the Tax Rate for 2021, and it appearing to the Commissioners' Court that said Tax Rate has been duly calculated in accordance with the law by the County Tax Assessor Collector and all required public notices fully filed, and the said Tax Rate, having been duly considered by the Court, on the motion made, seconded and carried, it is ordered by the Court that this said Tax Rate is, and is hereby approved and adopted as follows:


The Maintenance & Operation rate shall be	0.409784
The Interest & Sinking rate shall be	0.031574
Sub-Total	0.441358
The Special Road & Bridge rate shall be Per One Hundred Dollar Valuation	0.065515
The Total Tax Rate for FY 2021 shall be	0.506873
The Total Tax Rate for FY 2020 was	0.555190

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.


THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 0.005 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$5.00


