The sale will be held in the lobby of the North entrance of the north building of the Cass County Law Enforcement and Justice Center Facility Located at 604 Highway 8, North, Linden Texas 75563, or as Designated by the County Commission's office.

The United States Secretary of Housing and Urban Development will bid \$106,362.26 plus any additional accrual, fees, costs or charges incurred by the Secretary up to the date of sale.

There will be no proration of taxes, rents or other income or liabilities, except that the purchaser(s) will pay, at or before closing, his (their) pro-rata share of any real estate taxes that have been paid by the Secretary to the date of the foreclosure sale.
