Relays instructions or questions to/from remote units. Records and logs calls received, checks and maintains current information on computer. Monitors radios and maintains contact with operating units. Operator will be responsible for answering and dispatching 911 calls. Requires specialized training in radio techniques and handling of emergency response units.

Personal Job-Related Skills: Must be able to type. Some computer skills will be helpful but not necessary, as department will train new employee.
